

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

THE DECEDENT IS A 58-YEAR-OLD WHITE MALE WITH A HISTORY OF FINANCIAL PROBLEMS. HE HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN DESPONDENT AND EXPRESSED SUICIDAL IDEATIONS 7 YEARS AGO, BUT HE HAS NOT MENTIONED ANY DEPRESSION OR SUICIDAL THREATS RECENTLY. HE WAS LAST SEEN ALIVE BY HIS MOTHER ON THE LATE NIGHT OF 5/27/07 AND SHE FOUND HIM FULLY SUBMERGED IN THEIR BACKYARD SWIMMING POOL WITH A CINDER BLOCK TIED AROUND HIS ANKLES ON THE MORNING OF 5/29/07. 911 WAS CALLED ONER AN HOUR LATER AND FIRE FIGHTERS PULLED THE DECEDENT OUT OF THE POOL AND PRONOUNCED HIM DEAD AT SCENE. POLICE OFFICERS FOUND THE DECEDENT'S LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT AND AN "IN CASE OF TROUBLE" LETTER, BOTH DATED 5/26/07, WITH A PILE OF BILLS IN THE DECEDENT'S DRESSER. FOUL PLAY IS NOT SUSPECTED.

Investigation:

On 5/29/07 at 1318 hours, Officer Martinez reported this suicidal drowning death to Robin Webber. Supervisor Cheryl MacWillie assigned me this field call at 1345 hours. I arrived on scene at 1425 hours and departed at 1545 hours. Forensic Attendant Sergio Flores transported the decedent to the FSC at 1615 hours.

Location:

Swimming Pool, 11831 Lemay Street, North Hollywood 91606.

Informant/Witness Statements:

According to Officer Martinez and Officer Driotez, the decedent has been having financial problems. There is evidence that he has refinanced his house twice and still owes a lot of money on medical bills. The decedent lives with his mother, Louise Kelly, and she last saw him on Sunday, 5/27/07, when she went to sleep at 2300 hours. On Monday, 5/28/07, Kelly didn't see the decedent but assumed he was out with a friend. She became worried on 5/29/07 when she still had not seen the decedent and noticed his house pants were gone and his outdoor shoes were in his bedroom. Eventually Kelly looked in the backyard swimming pool at approximately 1030 hours on 5/29/07 and found the decedent in the bottom of the deep end of the pool. Since she had been having phone troubles earlier in the day, Kelly did not call 911 and waited until the decedent's girlfriend arrived at approximately 1145 hours. At that time the girlfriend called 911 and Los Angeles Fire Department Engine 89 responded. Fire fighters pulled the decedent out of the pool and determined that he was dead at scene at 1215 hours. The decedent had suicidal ideations when he went through a bad divorce in 2000 but has no known recent history of depression, suicidal ideations, or suicide attempts. Foul play is not suspected.

Louise Kelly indicates that the decedent is divorced and has no children. During the decedent's divorce in 2000 he became very despondent and Kelly moved into his house from New York to care for him. At that time the decedent told Kelly that he might commit suicide but would leave her everything. After several months his mental health improved but in 2001 his colon ruptured. He almost died and spent three months in the hospital and an additional month in a rehab facility. It took him over one additional year before he was able to regain his strength and go back to his normal life. On Saturday, 5/26/07, the decedent went out with a friend and told Kelly that he thought that the Scientologists might start harassing him again because of his recent postings on the internet. On the night of 5/27/07 Kelly and the decedent watched a movie. Before going to bed the decedent said that his friend was going to pick him up at the house on Monday morning. Kelly never saw the decedent on Monday, 5/27/07, but she was not worried until the decedent's girlfriend called her on Tuesday, 5/29/07, because the decedent did not show up for their date the night before. After that phone call Kelly searched the house and yard for some time before finding the decedent fully submerged in the deep end of the pool. Kelly later spoke with the friend who the decedent said was going to visit on Monday, but the friend said he never made plans to spend time with the decedent on that day. One week ago Kelly and the decedent watched an episode of "The Soprano's" where Tony Soprano's son attempted to commit suicide by jumping into a pool with cement bricks tied around his ankles. The decedent drank a lot of wine but did

not use illegal drugs. He was a Scientologist, but felt that L. Ron Hubbard commercialized the religion too much and he wrote several books on the topic. The decedent was having financial problems but he told Kelly that he had paid off all of his medical bills. The decedent has not mentioned wanting to harm himself within the past few years. He has never sought psychological treatment nor did he take any psychiatric medications.

Scene Description:

The decedent and his mother live in a small, one-story, single family home on a quiet residential cul-de-sac in North Hollywood. The house and yard are poorly maintained and run down. The house is cluttered, messy, and smells very strongly of cigarette smoke. Prior to my arrival officers found two pieces of paper - the decedent's Last Will and Testament dated 5/26/07 and a note titled "In Case of Trouble" - in the decedent's dresser with a pile of bills. The second note written to his mother, Louise Kelly, is also dated 5/26/07 and it indicates that he fears Scientologists will begin harassing him again. He also reminds her that she has power of attorney for him and dictates what he wants done with his cremains. The back yard has a small poorly maintained garden area and a fenced in pool. The rectangular shaped pool is approximately 10' by 25' and is an unknown depth in the deep end. The decedent is lying on the cement pool deck near the deep end. He is supine and covered by a wet, white sheet. His legs are straight and his arms are at his side. A thin, heavy-duty, plastic insulated, copper cable is wrapped twice around his left wrist. The end of that cord is sloppily wrapped in circles and appears to have been possibly tied to the cinder block or the decedent's right wrist. Another cable is wrapped and knotted around both of the decedent's ankles and an 18-pound cinder block. In each robe pocket the decedent has one small broken piece of red decorative brick. The combined weight of the two brick pieces are 3.5 pounds. Similar cinder blocks and red decorative brick are found in the garden area adjacent to the pool. Neither the police officers nor I were able to locate cable similar to the one the decedent had on his wrists and ankles.

Evidence:

I left the 18-pound cider block and red cable wire tied around the decedent's extremities on the decedent. I also collected two small pieces of decorative red brick that the decedent had in his robe pockets. This evidence was left with the decedent so that it could be examined by the deputy medical examiner during autopsy.

Body Examination:

The decedent is a well-nourished 58-year-old white male lying supine on a cement pool deck. He has gray and brown hair, blue eyes, natural lower teeth, no natural upper teeth, upper dentures, and he is clean shaven. He is wearing a white terry cloth robe, button-down shirt, undershirt, corduroy pants, underwear, a belt, and two slippers. He is soaking wet and swollen. The decedent's fingers are slightly waterlogged. Numerous healed surgical scars are noted on his abdomen. He has a healed tracheotomy scar on his neck. Petechial hemorrhages are noted in both eyes. His tongue is slightly protruding from between his clenched teeth. Rigor mortis is 3+ throughout his body and it breaks with hard pressure. There is dark purple lividity consistent with the decedent's current position that blanches with hard pressure. Purple livor mortis is also noted to the front portion of his body and it blanches with hard pressure. Ambient air temperature at scene at 1519 hours was 76° while the pool water temperature was 78° at 1521 hours. The decedent's liver temperature was 76° at 1523 hours. No external signs of trauma are noted.

Identification:

Louise Kelly viewed the decedent at scene on 5/29/07 and positively identified him as her son Kenneth Arthur Ogger.
